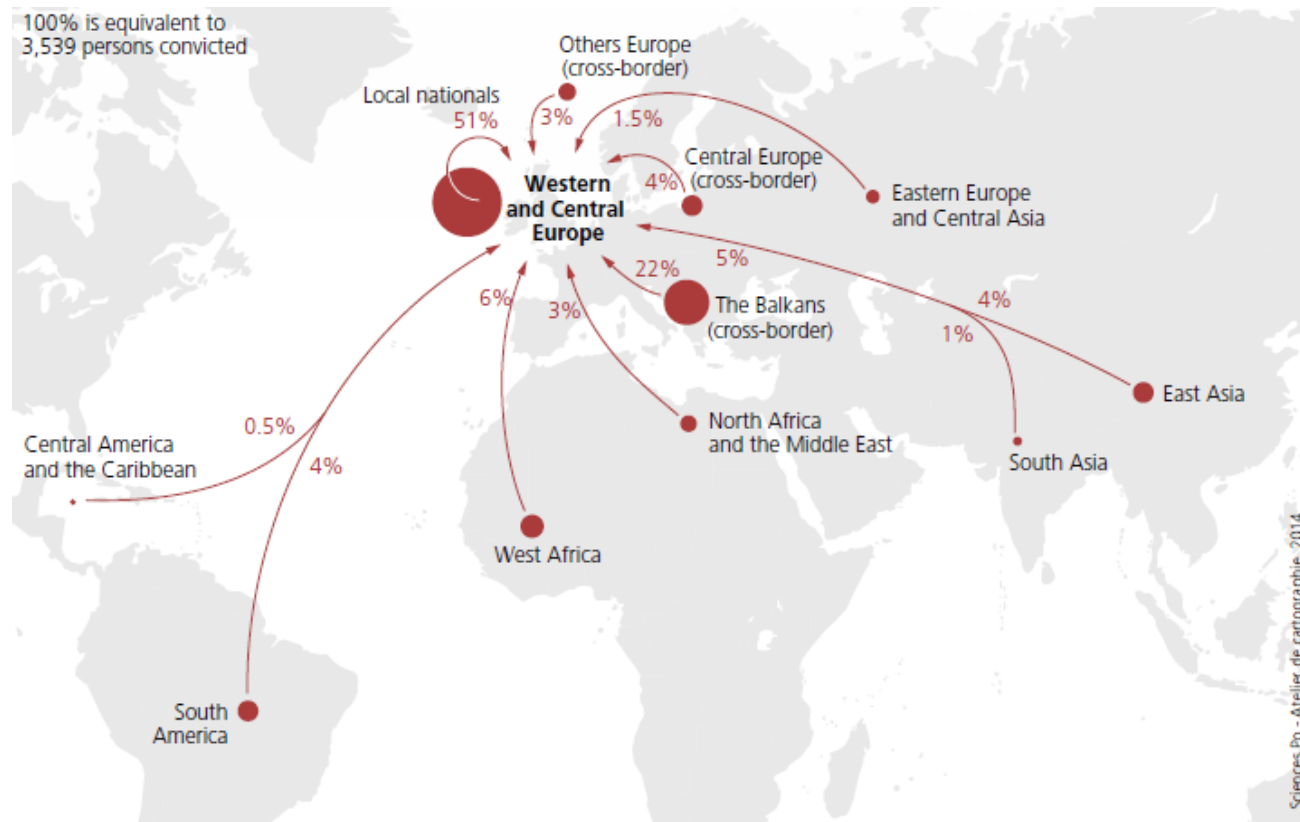

## 3. STATISTICS ACROSS EUROPE

### Registered victims

- ▶ 30, 146 victims in EU 2010 - 2012
- ▶ 80% female.
- ▶ 1 000+ minors were trafficked for sexual exploitation.
- ▶ 69 % trafficked for sexual exploitation.
- ▶ 95 % of registered for sexual exploitation were female.
- ▶ 71 % of registered for labour exploitation were male.
- ▶ 65 % of registered victims were EU citizens.
- ▶ No discernible trends in the variation of victim **data**

## 4. STATISTICS ACROSS EUROPE

### Traffickers

- ▶ 8 551 prosecutions for trafficking 2010-2012
- ▶ Over 70 % of traffickers were male.
- ▶ This is the case for suspects, prosecutions and convicted traffickers.
- ▶ 3 786 convictions for trafficking in human beings were reported by Member States over the three years

## 5. WHAT IS HUMAN TRAFFICKING?

- The modern-day slave trade-
- the process of enslaving a person.
- Tricked or kidnapped or coerced, and then taken into slavery.
- Tricked by the promise of a job or love or a better life in a new place.
- Then the trafficker sells the victim into forced labor or prostitution.
- Psychologically manipulated and physically abused,
- Forced to work in deplorable situations for little or no wages.
- Often the victim of sexual violence and rape,
- Often the victim of sexually transmitted diseases,
- and unwanted pregnancies.
